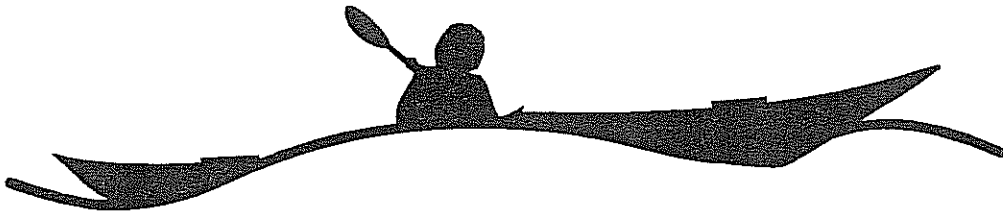




CLUB T-SHIRTS
