Note: All paddlers on ConnYak trips must have and wear: 1. The appropriate CG approved Personal Flotation Device, and W. A spray skirt. Their boat and equipment must meet CG requirements, including an appropriate signaling device. Paddlers are responsible for their own safety, including dressing for immersion.
